

Will the people who abide in Jannah be able to see Allah (SWT)?

With respect to your first question about the reward of men in Jannah it is sufficient to mention the words of Allāh:

"They shall have whatever they wish with in Paradise, if we wish for something, it will be there before us, and no one will find anything less than everything they could possibly seek. Allāh, the Almighty will inspire each to seek what is good, in accordance with their sincerity and spiritual striving in this life. their Lord, that is the reward of those who do good" (HQ 39:34)

However, what we should worry about is getting there, by working to be of those of sincerity and spiritual striving.

As to whether we will see Allāh, the Almighty in Janna it is sufficient to quote the following verse from the Holy Qur'ān,

"Upon that day faces shall be radiant, gazing upon their Lord." (HQ 75.22-23)

And there are many *Ahādīth* of the Messenger of Allāh (peace and blessings be upon him) that affirm this beholding of Allāh, too. (Kanz al-ummāl fi sunan aqwāl wa al-af'āl, Vol 14, pg 187-192, Dar al-kutub al-ilmīya). All the *Ahādīth* are general in their application, therefore they apply equally to both men and women.
